The participation fee is \$1,000 for business professionals (\$850 for early applicants) seeking to be matched with an arts organization for board service. Current board members can join the training for \$500 (\$425 for early applicants) if their nonprofit is a member of the Arts & Business Council. Many participants have their fees covered by their employers, but some pay themselves.
